- ❖ **Deadline for abstract submission: 31st August 2025.**



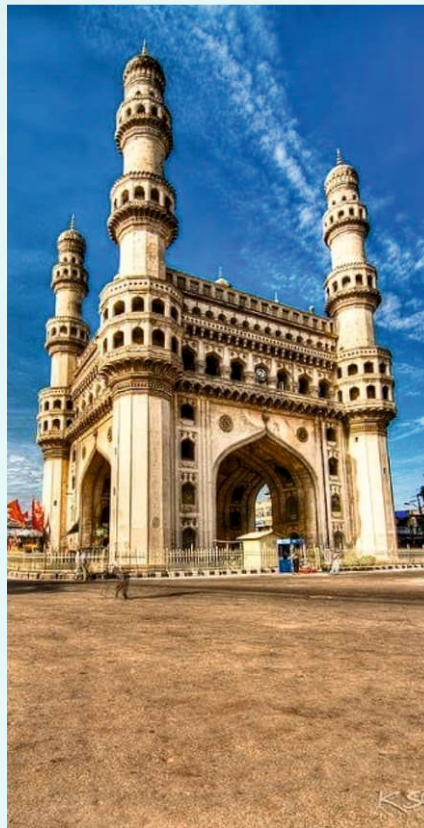
HOST CITY

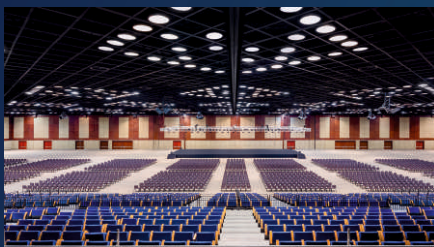
